

What to Expect on Your First Visit to POP Chorus

On your first chorus visit, expect a welcoming atmosphere, a chance to sing, and getting to know some of the other members. It's an informal time to see if the chorus is a good fit for you.

Here's a more detailed look at what to expect:

Welcoming Atmosphere:

You will be greeted when you walk in and asked to fill out an information sheet that will include how you heard about us and your vocal experience. This information will be used to follow up with you if there will be a change in the upcoming rehearsals.

Informal Exploration:

You'll have the chance to experience the music and the group dynamic before committing to anything.

Vocal Placement:

You may be asked to discuss your experience and sing a little bit (possibly Happy Birthday) in order to place you on a suitable vocal part where you will feel most successful.

Singing:

The chorus sings on risers, and you will be placed near someone who sings your same part and to answer any questions you may have. You'll be given copies of the music so that you can follow along and sing with us if you choose. There will be no pressure to sing or to sing perfectly! You will not be expected to read music, as many of our members do not. If you wish to learn some of the music after the first visit, you will be given access to the website where you can print the music and listen to the learning tracks.
